A KidZone Teacher interacts with, teachers and provides care for children participating in KidZone programs. KidZone teachers must demonstrate a positive attitude, be flexible and reliable, and possess effective verbal and listening skills. Most importantly, a KidZone teacher loves working with children in a loving, gentle manner.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Teach Children and Care for Children in KidZone Programs

- Review curriculum before children arrive
- Prepare the classroom with age appropriate centers or according to the curriculum
- Teach Bible based curriculum as provided by Coordinator

Supervise and Interact with the Children in the Classrooms and on the Playground

- Alert Coordinator if a parent is needed because of injury, separation anxiety, or behavior problems
- Change diapers, take children to the bathroom, and help children wash hands
- Insure the safety and well-being of children at all times
- Make sure room and toys are satisfactorily clean and ready for use by the KidZone class
